Support for local composting

Divert organic material from the landfill by funding and supporting community-based composting operations. Provide technical assistance to food scrap producers and ensure that Rhode Islanders have equitable access to composting options.



Surplus food waste donation tax credit

Create a tax credit for qualified taxpayers who donate food to Rhode Island organizations to address food insecurity, propel environmental sustainability, support local businesses, and help make surplus food donation a common practice.



Healthy school meals for all

Invest in children by providing free breakfast and lunch to all students, while promoting local food purchasing and ensuring culturally appropriate menus.



Urban and small farmer tax burden relief

Strengthen urban and small farmers by ensuring farming operations remain competitive by reducing tax burdens.
