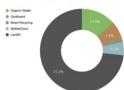
Key Takeaways & Event Review

Key Outcomes

At this event, we diverted a total of 376 lbs of organics from landfills, offsetting 269 net pounds of CO2

emissions. This is equivalent to greenhouse gas emissions from 261 miles driven by an average passenger vehicle, or .03 cars driven for a year. This is equivalent to carbon sequestered by two tree seedlings grown for ten years, or .14 acres of U.S. Greets in one year.
